Project description:

The project objective was to introduce the principles of the energy efficiency, renewable energy sources (RES) and ICT technology to the SMEs from the Sofia district and Nishava cross-border region, to increase awareness on applicability of the new technologies and innovations in achieving competitiveness and substantial benefits for the business organizations in the cross-border region, and to stimulate the cross-border business and technology cooperation. The project achieved the following results:

- Organization of two promoting conferences in Kostinbrod (Bulgaria) and in Nis (Serbia);
- Two seminars in Nis (Serbia) and two seminars in Kostinbrod (Bulgaria) were organized. The seminars covered the following topics: Awareness rising seminar concerning EU programmes and financial instruments awareness rising seminar concerning financial instruments for funding SMEs activities and project pre-financing;
- Implemented visits to SMEs and RTOs on both sides of the border – a total of 50 companies from both sides visited. A technical assessment of 30 companies from the cross-border territory (19 from Bulgaria and 11 from Serbia) was implemented;
- Elaboration of a web platform for exchange of information and communication of technology needs and offers. Currently all TO/TR for SMEs/RTOs/research driven SMEs/clusters are uploaded and visitors of the site can get information and contact details on themes and SMEs/RTOs of their interest. - Organization of two concluding conferences carried out in Kostinbrod (Bulgaria) and in Nis (Serbia) were organized and carried out in the 4th reporting period.
