Purchase and installation of heating/cooling ventilation (HVAC) system for Archaeological Site Lepenski Vir, village Boljetin, Municipality of Majdanpek, Serbia during three months.
Archaeological site consist of two buildings, The Main Building with amphitheatre and exhibition hall, and side building with office space (on the floor), Internet room (ground floor) and storage/toilette facilities (basement).

Heating, ventilation and acclimatisation in the Main building is provided by air systems – air condition chambers. Maximum volume of fresh per system is 100%(8000 m3/h) whereas minimal is depending on number of people entering the amphitheatre at the same time. Switch to saving mode is automatic driven by IC detector of empty room. Canal fan-cool units are to be installed at the gate of the amphitheatre providing “air curtain” which can provide satisfactory heating or cooling in case of small number of visitors.

In Side building, heating and cooling throughout the year must be provided at all three levels of the building (basement, ground floor and on the floor). Heating/cooling is to be provided by fan cool devices.
