Project description:

The project envisioned and achieved the following results:

- Two Opening Press Conferences in Nis and Sofia and two Final conferences as well as 2 Workshops and 14 Partnership meetings; Press conferences were widely covered in the local press; Two additional meetings between the experts were carried out due to the necessity of better synchronization between the researches;
- Nine studies were performed including: Developed Common Methodology; Hydro power energy study; Comparative study completed; Site study, Geological Analysis, Analysis of hydro power potential sites, Analysis of infrastructure, Environmental study, Anthropological research. Most of the studies were performed simultaneously on both side of the border by Bulgarian and Serbian teams.;
- Guide for implementation of small hydro screw drive developments in three languages: 750 copies - 250 in each language - Bulgarian, Serbian and English; 80 pages.

The project was successfully completed in April 2014.








