

Project description:

The project envisioned and achieved the following results:

- Organization of two workshops and two study visits for students and entrepreneurs about the production of the innovative fashion products;
- Conduction research on traditional design elements of the people from the eligible area;
- The adaptation of spaces for the establishment of Research and Creative at the Faculty of Technology in Leskovac and the Territorial Organization of Scientific and Technical Unions – Dupnitsa. The two centres were equipped with furniture, technical equipment and the relevant computer software, including with access to a professional textile and clothes design database;
- Organized trainings for work on the new software and using the professional database;
- Conducted a public competition for the development of modern fashion products, inspired by the cultural heritage of the Serbian and Bulgarian people;
- Conducted an Analysis of the attitudes of respondents about the acceptability of innovative fashion products;
- Organized exhibition and a fashion show of conceptual designs of modern fashion products inspired by the cultural heritage of Serbian and Bulgarian people in Leskovac;


